

# MODERATOR [ETD003]

## *Moderate Outcomes-based Assessment*

**SAQA Unit Standard:** 115759      **Credits:** 10      **NQF level:** 6

**Duration:** 3 days

### **OVERVIEW:**

This Moderator unit standard is for people who moderate or intend to moderate assessments against unit standards and/or qualifications. This unit standard will contribute towards the achievement of a variety of Education Training and Development Practices and Human Resource Development related qualifications.

This training looks at SAQA (South African Qualifications Authority) and the NQF (National Qualifications Framework) and it explains outcomes-based education in detail.

The candidate-moderator who has achieved this unit standard will be able to moderate assessment activities against the relevant standards and qualifications. The candidate-moderator will be able to use the prescribed Quality Assurance procedures in a fair, valid, reliable and practicable manner that is free of all bias and discrimination, paying particular attention to the three groups targeted for redress: race, gender and disability.

Successful candidates will be recognised as moderators in their field of expertise, after registering with the MICT or other relevant SETA.

For assessment against this unit standard:

- The candidate Moderator will submit a Portfolio of Evidence. This PoE will consist of a variety of formative exercises to assess the candidate's knowledge, as well as a practical assignment that will assess their application of moderation of assessments in the workplace. Results will be submitted to the ETDP (Education Training Development Practice) SETA (Sector Education & Training Authority) for registration as Moderators.

### **On completion of this training, participants will be able to:**

- Understand the need for quality assurance of assessments.
- Apply principles and methods of moderation.
- Explain moderation processes and procedures.
- Explain moderation of assessment instruments.
- Conduct moderation of recognition of prior learning programmes.
- Write a moderation report and support and develop assessors.

**NB. It is preferred that attendees first attend the Assessor training workshop before attempting the Moderator training. This will ensure that all candidate moderators are on the same level in terms of understanding Learner needs, assessment practices and processes and will allow the Moderator training to be presented at the highest standard.**
