Today most mobile phones and devices have onboard video cameras. Teens are often the first to experiment with these features. This hands-on, interactive workshop will empower them to produce quality video content. This workshop will give you an introduction to the basic creative and technical knowledge you need to shoot great videos on your mobile device. You will learn advanced techniques when shooting and editing and you will produce a short video by the end of the course.
